## Works begin in November

To further improve drainage in South Parade, Blackburn, we are installing new pipes that will direct more water from the overflow structures on the north side into Melbourne Water's underground drainage system.

The pipe and pits are scheduled to be installed in December 2019 and reinstatement works will be complete by the end of January, 2020. Further details are provided below.

### Activities taking place

Works will take place in South Parade between the outlet structures and the IGA supermarket. The works will involve:

- Establishing a work zone with temporary fencing and barriers
- Pruning trees to provide adequate clearance for trucks and equipment
- Trucks delivering materials and equipment to the site
- Trenching across South Parade using excavators
- Concreting as part of the pipe installation
- Reinstatement works including asphaltting, line-marking and landscaping

### What to expect

Construction activity will take at the following dates and times:

- 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 7am to 3pm on Saturdays and Sundays between 25 November and 23 December, 2019.
- 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday between 3 January and 31 January, 2020.

There may be times that we need to work outside of these hours, including at night, and we will provide you with further notice if required.

### Temporary car park and traffic changes

There will be temporary changes to traffic and parking in South Parade while the works are completed. Please note that:

- South Parade will remain open, and access to homes and businesses will be maintained at all times.

- To ensure the safety of our workforce and the public, the speed limit in the work zone will be reduced to 40km/h and traffic control staff will help manage vehicle and pedestrian movements.
- To enable two-way traffic to be maintained in South Parade, up to 55 car spaces on South Parade (west of Main Street) will be closed from late November 2019 until the end of January 2020. Other parking in the area will remain open.

### How this may affect you

Residents and businesses in the area may notice some noise and dust during the works.

We will take steps to keep the impacts to a minimum, including by using less noisy equipment where possible and wetting down work areas to reduce dust.

There may also be minor delays to traffic on South Parade during the works. Please take care when driving through the area.
